Woodbridge House overlooks the Swan River near the historic National Trust Classified Town of Guildford, only 25 minutes' east of Perth. This splendid old two-storey residence is owned by the National Trust and features white iron lacework, wide verandahs and a central tower. Woodbridge House was built in 1883 and 1885 for Charles Harper and family, the house was considered one of the most gracious in Western Australia. Its interior has been carefully restored and furnished to reflect the late Victorian and early Edwardian periods. The old coach house adjacent to Woodbridge is now a tea-room and gift shop. Opens Thursday to Tuesday 1.00pm - 4.00pm.
