- 10.30 am Decide to drive to the Chocolate Company to watch the making of the chocolate before indulging in a free taste.
- 11.00am Head over the road to Lancasters Wines for a free Wine and Cheese tasting.
- 11.30pm Drive up to Elmars Smallgoods and watch the brewers creating the local amber.
- 12.00 pm Time to stretch your legs and walk the Maali Footbridge, while there why not stop in the park to enjoy a picnic lunch.
- 1.00 pm Move on to take in some local indigenous culture at the Maalinup Aboriginal Gallery where you will find local artists at work, have an opportunity to taste real bush tucker and even throw a hand made boomerang.
- 1.30 pm Time to try a little more of Swan Valleys best at Twin Hill – let's face it you can never tire of fine wine and cheese.
- 2.00pm Browse the delights of Panache House & Gardens .
- 2.30 pm The Valley even caters for non drinkers at Kafarelas Vineyard. You can sample non alcoholic wine, grape juice and a variety of seasonal produce.
- 3.00 pm Something else to delight your senses on this trip around the valley is the free tastings of dried fruit and nuts, honey, preserves and confectionary at Swan Valley Central.
- 3.30 pm Some Mondo Nougat might just be the sugar hit you need to get you around those last free attractions of the valley.
- 4.00 pm Although the Swan Valley is famous for its premium wine why not try some canefire rum. The Great Northern Distillery offers visitors a chance to watch it being made through their viewing window.
- 4.30 pm Gomboc Gallery and Sculpture Park is truly unique and visitors have the opportunity to interact with the art and the artist.
