



Cultural Discover Trail

Suggested Itinerary

With its blend of indigenous, colonial and Southern European history, the Swan Valley is a fascinating place to explore. Guildford is the state's oldest market town and is classified by the National Trust.

- 9.30 am** Your discovery starts here at the Swan Valley Visitor Centre which is located in the old Guildford Courthouse (c1866), and is also home to some beautifully curated interpretive displays.
- 9.45 am** Grab a free heritage walk trail map from Visitor Centre staff to help guide you around this beautifully preserved historic town.
- 10.30am** Watch the world go by as you sip a coffee in any of the Guildford Tea Rooms while contemplating your next move.
- 11.30 am** Time to leave Historic Guildford and head off into the Swan Valley. Travel up West Swan Road to the Paul Dowe & Partners Gallery where you will be able to browse and purchase fine art.
- 12.15pm** Next stop is Maalinup Aboriginal Gallery to buy some bush tucker food and other gifts as presents to take home.
- 12.45 pm** Stop for lunch at Edgecombe Bros and enjoy a local gourmet platter and a glass of wine. We know that you will be blown away by Alf's fresh produce so why not buy some to enjoy at home.
- 2.00 pm** All Saint's Church is the oldest church in WA and also the spot where Captain Stirling declared Perth a colony and can be visited any time and not just on Sunday.
- 2.30 pm** Stop at John Kosovich Wines to visit their underground cellar and you will find yourself speaking to the third generation winemaker, who tells you this is the oldest wine region in WA and not only makes fabulous table wines, but makes some of the best fortified wines in Australia.
- 3.15 pm** Time for afternoon tea at Taylors Art & Coffee House and don't be afraid to indulge a little more - we suggest the Gluten Free Chocolate and Orange cake.
- 4.00 pm** Want more? Why not get the staff at the Visitor Centre to book you in to one of the beautiful B & B's and catch an evening performance at the Historic Garrick Theatre.
