Suggested Itinerary

The valley has attracted a community of talented artisans, potters, painters and sculptors that is all on display and for sale in the Swan Valley.

- 9.00 am** Depart Perth (25 minutes to Swan Valley)
- 9.25 am** Arrive at the Swan Valley Visitor Centre in Guildford and collect your FREE Artisans on Swan Trail guide and map.
- 9.35 am** Wander next door to the Guildford Potters Studio and browse the amazing array of different products.
- 10.00am** Time to leave Historic Guildford and head off into the Swan Valley. Travel up West Swan Road to the Paul Dowe & Partners Gallery which features photographic fine art prints, canvas prints and limited editions of Western Australia
- 10.45 am** For something different now visit Mal Craig's studio in Whiteman Park where you will see our native Australian animals created from wire mesh.
- 11.30am** Next stop is Maalinup Aboriginal Gallery where you will see traditional indigenous art. You might even be tempted to try some bush tucker food and buy some gifts to take home.
- 12.30 pm** Stop for lunch at Valley View Restaurant where you can enjoy art and food.
- 1.45 pm** No it is not an Illusion just another fantastic gallery. At Illusionary Art you will be fascinated by the unique 3 dimensional optical illusions he creates on flat sheets of aluminium.
- 2.15 pm** Time for afternoon tea at Taylors Art & Coffee House. Jude Taylor is a well respected lino-cut artist and you can enjoy her art and others on display whilst enjoying some of the Valley's best coffee and cake.
- 3.00 pm** Finally, stop in to meet the "Wizard of Fire" Antonio Battistessa at his studio where he forges works of art from iron and other metals.
